

PRAYING THE PRAYER OF COMMAND

(example for physical healing)

“Lord, I give you thanks and praise for your beloved daughter/son. I thank you for the healing that you desire to give *(person’s name.)* Praying in Jesus’ name and with His power and authority, I speak to the pain in *(person’s name ...knee, hand, back, etc)* and command it to release itself; to get out right at this moment and go quickly and quietly to the cross of Jesus, never to return. I now pray for the Holy Spirit to be poured out into the area where the pain has dwelt, healing the very cause of the pain. Thank you Lord for what you are doing at this moment. Thank you Jesus.

It’s in your name we pray.” AMEN.

Continue to prayer the Prayer of Command, as the Spirit leads, checking in with the individual after each time the Prayer of Command is used for changes in pain level.

Conclude with prayers of thanksgiving and for the Spirit to complete the healing, if needed, at the conclusion of the prayer session.

It is important to personalize the Prayer of Command, praying with the words the Spirit gives you. Always pray in Jesus’ name and with His power and authority when using the Prayer of Command!
